
Uploading work into Google Classroom

Option 1: Uploading scanned pages.


Step 1: Pick 1 Literacy, 1 Maths, 1 other learning area from the booklet (Health, Art, Science, History etc.)

Step 2: Scan page/s and save to computer or USB.


Step 3: Go to classroom.google.com.



Step 5: Click View assignment.





Option 2: Uploading a photo.


Step 1: Pick 1 Literacy, 1 Maths, 1 other learning area from the booklet (Health, Art, Science, History etc)

Step 2: Download and Open the Google classroom app on a phone.


Step 3: Click the class > Classwork > the assignment.


